

COAST CITIES TOURNAMENT RULES – 2009

- 1) The Tournament will be played according to current regular season Little League Rules of play unless specifically noted in the following.
- 2) A coin toss prior to the game will determine the home team.
- 3) Only one manager and two coaches are permitted in the dugout. Only the coaches on the submitted roster are allowed to be in the dugout.
- 4) Discipline and good sportsmanship shall be maintained at all times. This applies to the dugout as well as the stands. Managers are responsible for the conduct of players, coaches and parents/fans.
- 5) Every player must play at least every other inning defensively. “Bat Around” is used, every player in attendance must be in the batting order.
- 6) If a player leaves the game for any reason, their next at bat will not be considered an out.
- 7) A 10 run mercy rule will be in effect. The losing team must bat four times.
- 8) No new inning will start after two hours. Tie games will be continued past the two hour limit.
- 9) Majors will not have a run rule per inning. Minors will have a 5 run rule per inning. The sixth inning in a minor game will not have a run rule.
- 10) Games may not be protested in the usual manner. All protests must be resolved prior to the next play. Any protest will be resolved by the umpire and tournament committee.
- 11) If a manager, coach, spectator or player is ejected from a game, he/she must immediately leave the playing and spectator areas. Failure to do so will result in a forfeit. Ejection from a game carries a three game suspension.

12) Pitching:

- A) League age 12 year olds may not pitch in Minors
- B) Little League regular season pitch count rules apply (Option 1). Pitch count from Little League games outside of this tournament will also be used to determine pitchers eligibility.
- C) Once a pitcher is removed from the mound, he/she may not pitch in that game

13) Teams must start and finish the game with 9 players per the little league rules. Teams are, however, allowed to borrow a player from a lower division team based on the following guidelines:

- The players lower division team cannot be entered in the Coast Cities tournament.
- The player cannot pitch.
- You may only bring up enough players to give you a maximum of 10 players at a game. Example: If you have 8 players from your regular roster then you are allowed to borrow 1 or 2 players from a lower division team.
