



Age and Address Verification FAQs

The following FAQ's address questions we commonly receive about our Age and Address Verification event. Please review these FAQ's and contact us via e-mail at info@dml.org if you have any questions.

Question 1: What is Age/Address Verification?

Answer: Typically held in the first week of December, this event (formally called "Walk-in Verification") provides parents and league officials the opportunity to fulfill Player Age and Address verification.

Question 2: Why does Del Mar Little League do this?

Answer: Little League International requires all local Little Leagues to verify the Age and Address of all their players. Because we are affiliated with Little League, we are bound to this requirement.

Question 3: Who has to attend this event?

Answer:

- (1) All players new to DMLL, first year or otherwise.
- (2) All players who have moved since last verifying their address.
- (3) All players who did NOT verify age and address in a prior season.

Question 4: We played in Carmel Valley Youth Baseball last year. Do we need to attend?

Answer: Yes. Del Mar Little League is not affiliated with Carmel Valley Youth Baseball.

Question 5: We played in the Ecker YMCA T-Ball program last year. Do we need to attend?

Answer: Yes. Del Mar Little League is not affiliated with the Ecker YMCA.

Question 6: We played in another Little League last year. Do we need to attend?

Answer: Yes.

Question 7: What will happen if I do NOT verify my players age/address?

Answer: Your player will not be placed on a team and will not be permitted to participate in any Del Mar Little League activities.

Question 8: We played in Del Mar Little League last season, but we've moved. Do we need to attend?

Answer: Yes. If you still live within our boundaries, we only need to verify the new address. If you have moved out of our boundaries, you'll need to fill out a waiver form. For more information about that process, email us at info@dml.org.

Question 9: Our player is new, but we have an older player in DMLL. Do we need to attend?

Answer: Yes. You must verify the age and address of the new player.

Question 10: We played Fall Ball with DMLL, but have not played in a prior Spring season. Do we have to attend?

Answer: Yes. Requirements to participate in our Fall program are different and we did not do a verification at that time.

- Question 11: **Do we need to attend this event every year?**
Answer: Probably Not. In most cases, a player's verification only needs to be performed once. Policy changes from Little League, All-Star selection or other reasons *may* require that you verify your player again at another time. If this becomes the case, we will notify you at that time.
- Question 12: **My player now lives with his (mother/father/other family member). Do I have to attend?**
Answer: Yes, if your player's address has changed, you must attend the event
- Question 13: **My player has changed schools, but we still live at the same address. Do we need to re-verify?**
Answer: No.
- Question 14: **Can I register at this event?**
Answer: Probably not. We would prefer that you register online before you come to the Age/Address Verification event.
- Question 15: **We won't be able to attend the event on the date it is being held. Do you have a makeup date?**
Answer: Yes. We have a "Last Chance" event schedule. Please see the Calendar of Events on our website
- Question 16: **We can't make the Last chance event either? What do I do?**
Answer: E-mail the league at info@dml.org and we'll try to work out other arrangements. You must complete the verification, however, or your player will not be placed on a team.
- Question 17: **What will happen if I fail to verify my players age/address?**
Answer: Again, your player will NOT be placed on a team and will not be permitted to participate in Del Mar Little League.
- Question 18: **What documents do I need to verify Age?**
Answer: A certified birth certificate with embossed seal (no photocopies will be accepted) or your child's passport. - Question 19: **What documents do I need to verify Address?**
Answer: Little League requires 3 separate items to demonstrate proof of residence. Please see this link for more information: <http://www.dml.org/info/info.php#walkin> .
- Question 20: **Will your league make any exceptions?**
Answer: No, we cannot. No verification, no baseball, no kidding.
